

Moodle: Quizzes (students)

1. Find the Quiz



Look for Activities: You can find all the course quizzes from the Activities box on the left, by clicking on the “Quizzes” link. You can also look for a specific quiz in a weekly summary in the middle section. Click on the quiz title to go to the summary.

2. Take the Quiz

Prepare: Read the quiz instructions carefully. Some quizzes will allow multiple attempts, but for more you will only get once chance. Also, some quizzes are timed. The timer continues counting down after you start the quiz, even if you close the window or shut off the computer. You can always log back in and get back into the quiz if you have not yet submitted it for grading and if the time is not expired.

Attempt: Click the “Attempt quiz now” button when you are ready to take the quiz. There can be one page or multiple pages on a quiz. **Remember to save your progress often by clicking the “Save without submitting” button.** When you are done and ready to submit the quiz for grading, click the “Submit all and finish” button at the bottom of the page. If you exceed the time limit, the quiz will automatically be submitted in its current state.

3. Potential Problems

Close and Restart: If you notice unusual behaviors or anything that doesn't seem to be working right, you may need to close your browser window down completely (and sometimes even your whole computer), then restart it and log back into Moodle.

Do not use Safari: Safari, an Apple's web browser is not fully compatible with Moodle. We recommend you to use another browser such as Firefox.

4. Review Your Quiz
