

## **NMETH 801 Capstone Clinical Investigative Project**

### Course Description

Capstone project reflects culmination practice inquiry knowledge and competencies. Students collaborate with clinicians, consumers, faculty or fellow students to examine clinical questions which involve translating evidence to practice, and ultimately informs and influences care and enhances health outcomes.

*Prerequisite:* Permission of supervisory committee; completion of practice inquiry core courses.

### Course Objectives

1. Appreciate and successfully engage in **collaborative** partnership building with clinicians, consumers, faculty and/or fellow students.
2. Demonstrates a **scientific curiosity and critique** stance towards specialized practice
3. Value and adhere to ethical and **human subject** guidelines.
4. Design and implement a scholarly project that entails addressing a question about some element of **translating evidence to practice**.
5. **Analyze results** and its **implications for future clinical research and practice** at agency and at the local, regional and/or national level.
6. **Disseminate results** to appropriate audiences within the agency and whenever possible outside the agency at the local, regional and national level.
